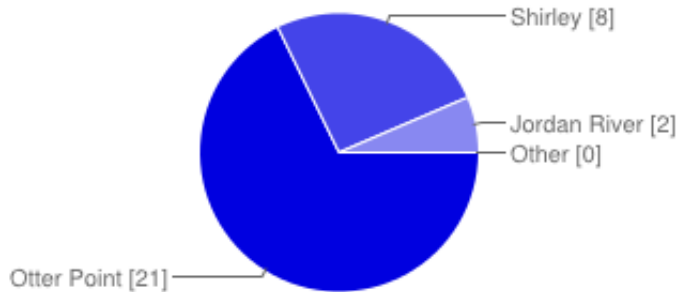

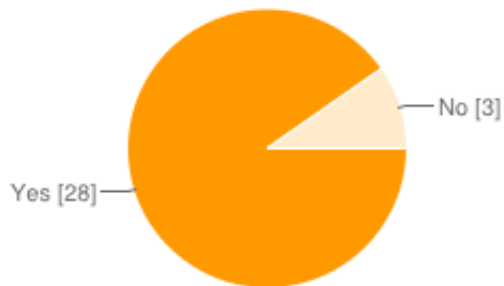

Which community do you live in?



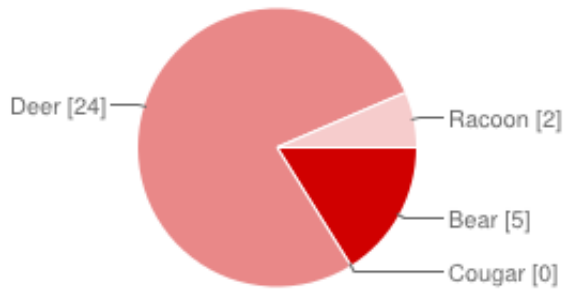

Have you had an interaction with wildlife on your property in the last two years?



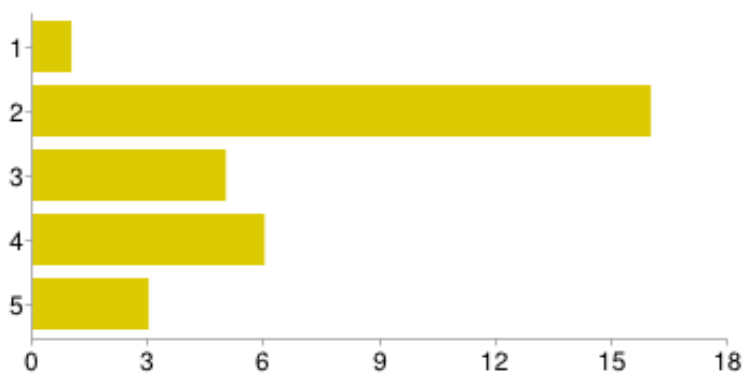

Which wildlife do you experience most frequently?



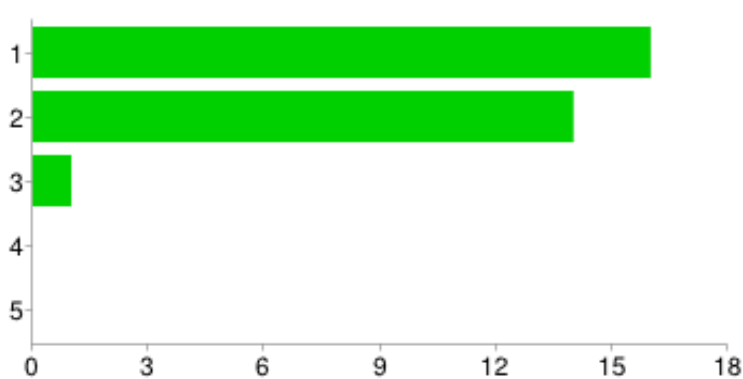

### Bear [How frequently do you estimate you have experiences with wildlife?]



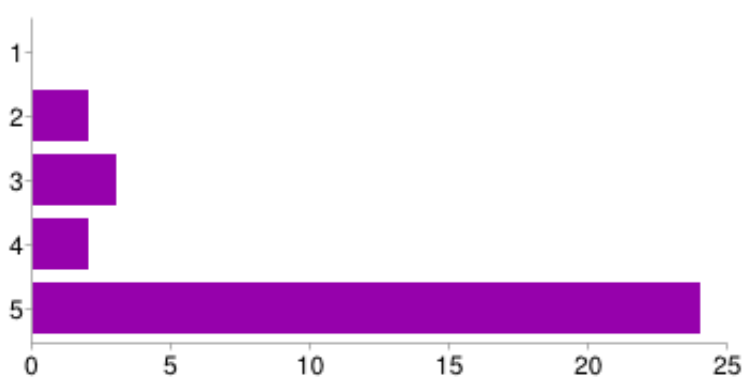

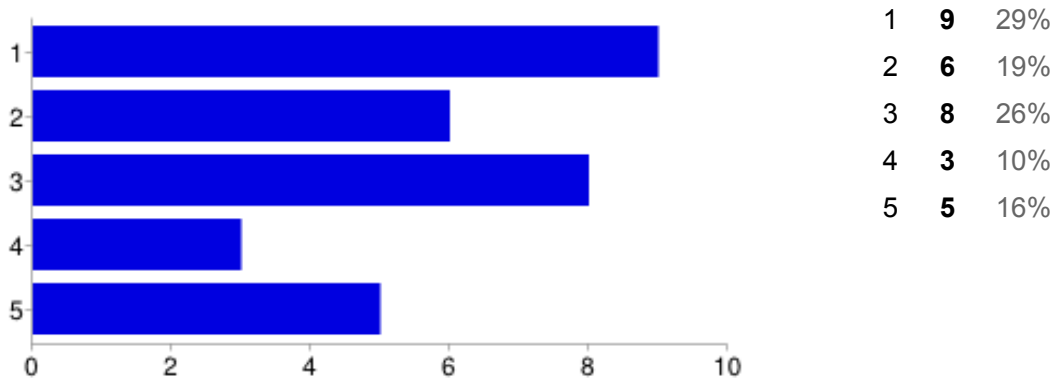

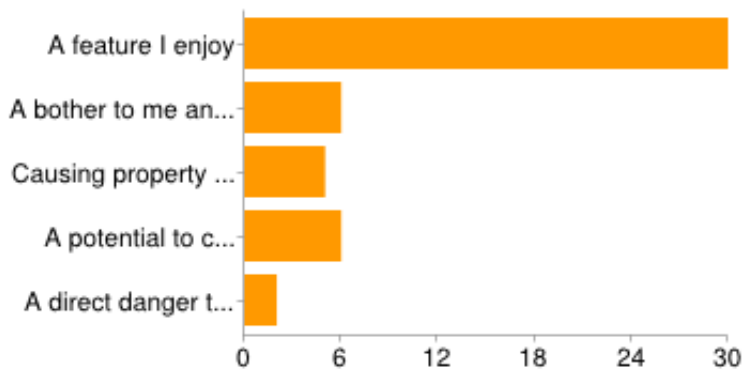

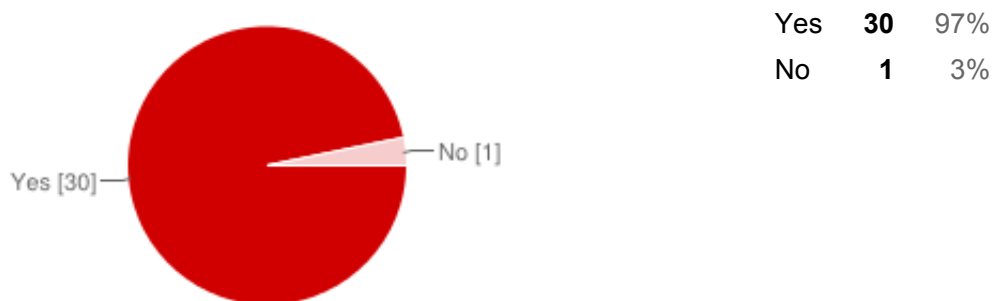

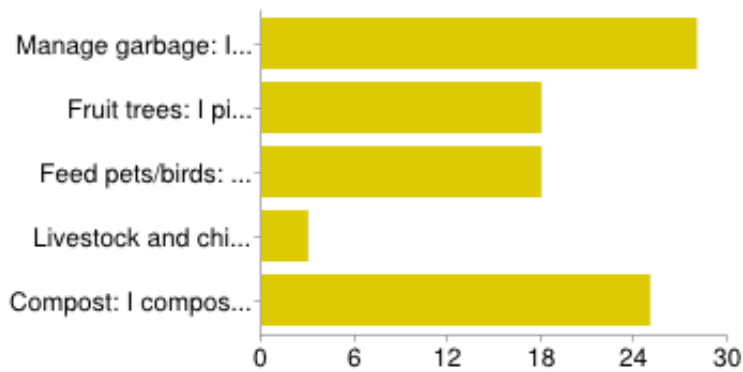

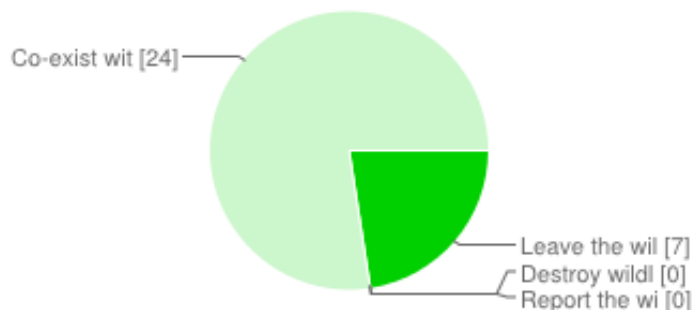


## Do you practise these attraction management solutions



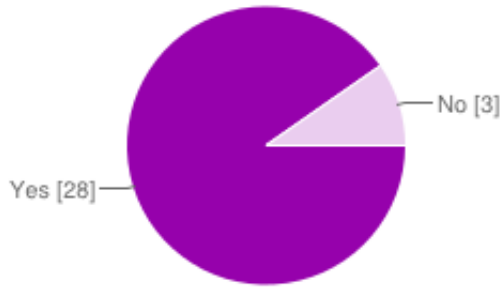
